

SIDEWALK CAFÉ FEES and TIMELINES (2012)

Step 1 Submit the Sidewalk Café License Application Form and fees to Current Planning or Transportation Services.	1 week	\$100(non refundable)
Steps 2 Arrange & attend on- site meeting with Transportation Operations to review site context and general compliance with Sidewalk Café Guidelines.	1-2 weeks	None
Step 3 Applicant applies for a Development Permit to Current Planning Branch.	3 weeks	\$235. + \$100, if notification is required.
Step 4 Applicant enters into a Sidewalk Café License Agreement with Transportation Operations.	2-4 weeks	\$100 transferred from Step 1. Renewal Fees \$100/5 years
Step 5* Applicant applies for a Building Permit if construction of awnings/canopies and /or decks are involved.	2-4 weeks	\$9.80 per \$1000. of construction value. Minimum \$146.
Step 6 A) Food Handling Permit from Alberta Health Services, and	2 weeks	A) \$100.
B) Liquor License from Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission, if alcohol beverage is contemplated.	3 weeks	B) \$200. (Non refundable.) \$200 per Year –Licence Fee
Step 7* Applicant secures a Final Inspection Certificate, if a Building Permit was issued.	1 week	N/A



- 7. Additional Parking is not required


PROPOSAL – Major Sidewalk Café





- 11. Additional Parking, loading/unloading spaces are not required




